- Entries submitted online will be acknowledged via email.
- Exhibits must be submitted and paid for by the closing date.
- When paying fees by credit card, exhibitors must ensure that sufficient funds are available at the time of entry. Failure to do so will result in non-acceptance of entries.

Members of the RA&HS, \$9.00

Non-members of the RA&HS, \$11.00

Age and Side classes, \$2.50 each

No refund of entry fees will be made after the closing date of entries.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

All entries must be submitted online www.theshow.com.au

- Entries submitted online will be acknowledged via email.
- The cats name, registered number, council where registered, date of birth, sire and dam, breed, colour and breeder must be stated on the entry form. Details should be as per the cat's registration certificate.
- Specify the exact colour, pattern and description of each cat and whether longhair or shorthair (e.g., Blue Spotted Tabby Selkirk Rex Shorthair etc.).
- Kittens can only be entered in kitten classes, and side classes.
- Exhibitors must be the registered owner/lessee of the exhibit. If exhibits are registered in joint names, they must be entered in joint names. Exhibits entered in Cattery or Business names will not be accepted.
- Please Note: As there is a limit to the number of cats that can be accommodated in the present venue, entries will be determined strictly according to the number of exhibits entered in each breed. If numbers are too large, some breeds may be moved to another day. Exhibitors will be notified of any change.

Registrations/Age Qualification

Kittens over five months and cats/kittens within three months of transfer from interstate must be registered with FASA or GCCFSA. All kittens must be litter registered.

Interstate exhibits must be registered within their own State of domicile with a council recognised by ACF or CCCA.

The age of all cats will be the actual age on the first day of the Royal Adelaide Show (month refers to calendar month).

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES

Friday 14th July 2023

The following conditions will strictly apply:

- All entries must be in the Society's possession at its Administration Office by 5.00 pm (CST) on Friday 14 July 2023.
- Entry forms by facsimile, paper or email will not be accepted.
- A late entry option is available under the following conditions:
 - Late entries may only be submitted online and will be accepted for 7 days after the official closing date (by 5.00 pm CST)
 - An additional fee equivalent to three times the standard entry fee is paid.

Absolutely no exception to the above conditions will be made to any exhibitor under any circumstance.

MEMBERSHIP

Exhibitors need not be members of the RA&HS.

WITHDRAWALS

Every cat entered must be exhibited unless a certificate signed by the exhibitor or his authorised agent is lodged with the Convenor before the day of exhibition stating that the animal is unable to compete for one of the following reasons:

- The cat has died;
- The cat is unfit for exhibition due to injury or disease (confirmed by veterinary surgeon's certificate);
- The cat has become ineligible for the class entered;
- The cat is 28 days or more pregnant;
- Some other cause which the Society considers reasonable.

Exhibitors must notify the GCCFSA Coordinator of any cats or kittens that will not be exhibited at least 24 hours before the day of exhibition.

Failure to comply with this rule will render the exhibitor liable to a fine of \$15 for each cat not exhibited. Non-payment of these fines may debar such persons from exhibiting at future Royal Adelaide Shows.

Erin was licensed to judge Group Two in 2001, Group Three in 2006, and completed Group One in 2008 to become an all-breeds cat judge.

Erin is an international cat judge having judged in the USA for TICA, Philippines, China, UK and New Zealand, as well as in most States of Australia. Erin enjoys judging and breeding both cats and dogs: she says “quality animals are my interest and passion”.

Erin started exhibiting in the early sixties and registered “Quanmarra” prefix in 1971 just prior to importing her foundation Salukis from the UK. She commenced breeding Siamese and Oriental Shorthairs in partnership with Penny Dunkley 21 years ago, again using the “Quanmarra” prefix. They have enjoyed showing several winning cats and have exported Oriental Shorthairs to the USA and to Europe, with those cats having some very prestigious wins, including All Breeds International Cat of the Year for TICA in 2000. Erin believes that we all have a responsibility to put some effort back into the animal fancy, to make it a better hobby for everyone. When not at cat or dog shows, Erin can be found at Paws and Whiskers, a “five-star” boarding complex, she owns in partnership with Penny Dunkley.

A challenge certificate may be awarded to the winning entry in the domestic and companion neuter male and neuter female classes if recommended by the judge.

Pedigree Classes

A challenge certificate may be awarded to the winning entries in the Open, Champion, Grand Champion, Double Grand Champion, Bronze Double Grand Champion, Silver Double Grand Champion and Gold Double Grand Champion classes of each breed (except in any other variety or provisional breeds) if recommended by the judge.

A challenge certificate may be awarded to the winning entries in the Open Neuter, Premier Neuter, Grand Premier Neuter, Double Grand Premier Neuter, Bronze Double Grand Premier Neuter, Silver Double Grand Premier Neuter and Gold Double Grand Premier Neuter classes of each breed (except in any other variety or provisional breeds) if recommended by the judge.

Major Award Winners

Cats winning major awards may be invited by the Judge to be exhibited on the last day. Exhibitors must bring their original slip for vetting-in. Failure to attend will result in forfeiture of awards. Interstate and far distant South Australian exhibits can apply for exemption from returning on the last day. Arrangements for exemption must be made with the Convenor prior to the last day. No prize will be awarded unless the exhibit is, in the opinion of the judge, worthy.

Prize Cards will be awarded. Special awards will be allotted to classes where entries warrant it.

SPONSORSHIP OF AWARDS

Trophy donations from Clubs and Individuals will be acknowledged in the Catalogue. Please indicate on the entry form if you are interested in sponsoring any awards.

It would be appreciated if all trophies were delivered to the Administration Office at the Showground or to the Section Convenor at least 10 days prior to the opening day of the Show.

Prizes will be listed in the Cat Catalogue.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

All prize money won during the Royal Adelaide Show will be paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) only.

PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID BY THE END OF OCTOBER.

Any trophy, prize or prize money not claimed by 11 December of the current year, shall be deemed forfeited by the exhibitor and the RA&HS shall no longer be liable to pay or provide the prize.

The Society makes every endeavour to ensure all prizes listed are accurate at the time of publishing. Should a cash prize be withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to publishing, the prize will revert back to the competition's default amount where applicable. Vouchers, product, or trophies withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to publishing will not be replaced. It is the responsibility of the prize winner to follow-up with the Society any sponsored prize (cash, voucher, product, trophy) they believe they are entitled to prior to 30 November in the year of the prize being awarded. The Society will not follow-up prize sponsors after this date or review any prizes that may have been incorrectly awarded.

PRIZE MONEY AND GST

Prize money as stated in the Competition Schedule does not include GST.

The prize money which we pay to successful exhibitors depends on information provided to us. If you confirm that you are GST registered and provide your Australian Business Number (ABN), we will pay the appropriate prize money plus 10% GST. We will provide you with a Recipient Created Tax Invoice which you will need to submit to the Australian Taxation Office.

If you confirm you are registered for GST, in entering the competition, you acknowledge your agreement to the following:

- You will not issue a tax invoice to the RA&HS in respect to prize money received.
- You will notify the RA&HS if you cease to be registered for GST.

If you provide your Australian Business Number but are not registered for GST, we will pay the prize money as detailed in the Competition Schedule without reference to the GST.

If you confirm you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, we will pay the prize money as detailed in the Competition Schedule without reference to GST.

LOCATION OF EXHIBITS

The Cat competition will be held in the Pet Centre located in the new State Basketball Centre southern end.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES FOR EVERY DAY

Arrival and vetting: 7.15 am

Judging: 8.30 am

Departure: 5.15 pm

All cats **MUST** arrive by 7.15 am every day for examination by the Society's veterinary surgeon.

Cats **MUST** be benched and the pavilion cleared by 8.15 am on the day on which they are to be exhibited.

Cats that do not arrive in time for vetting on the day on which they are to be exhibited will be refused entry.

Vaccination certificates are required for all kittens and **MUST** now be provided at vetting. Please ensure that kittens can be identified on the vet card and the original stickers and vet signatures are available. Kittens must have at least two vaccinations. Exhibitors should ensure they return to the Pet Centre by 5.00 pm to prepare to remove their cats at 5.15pm.

The Cat section of the Pet Centre will close at 5.15 pm and cats are not to be removed before 5.15 pm.

There will be no admittance during judging between 8.30 am and 11.00 am on all days except the last Saturday and Sunday.

On the last Saturday there will be a presentation of all Domestic and Companion Awards once judging has been completed.

On the last Sunday the pavilion will be closed from 8.30 am to 9.30 am and then at 9.30 am there will be a presentation of the Major Awards, followed by a presentation of Top 15 Awards and Supreme Exhibit in Show.

* Exhibits received after the set down time will not be judged.

PRE-PURCHASE CAR PARK

Rose Terrace Car Park #2 is allocated for the use of competitors in the Cat competition. Car park passes will be available for pre-purchase.

Competitors are advised to purchase their car park passes early as the allocation of parking spaces is limited.

Car parking on Sunday 10 September will be made available to competitors who qualify throughout the week of the Royal Adelaide Show. Arrangement will be communicated to competitors at the time.

ENTRY PASSES

1-2 cats will receive one-day entry pass.

3-4 cats will receive 2 one-day entry passes.

5 or more will receive 3 one-day entry passes.

One additional day pass will be issued by the Convenor to exhibitors returning for judging on Sunday 10 September.

To have upgrades in the catalogue they must be submitted by Wednesday 2nd August 2023.

Final Title Upgrades for Judges Slip (changes will not be listed in Catalogue) by Wednesday 16th August 2023.

No further upgrades will be accepted after this date.

ALL UPGRADES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE ABOVE DATES.

Any acknowledgement of upgrade will be sent via email by the closing date specified.

IMPORTANT

It is important that you either:

- Confirm you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, or
- Confirm you are entering as a GST registered business and supply your ABN

Failure to do either of the above will require the RA&HS to withhold tax, at the maximum tax rate, from prize money in accordance with Australian tax legislation.

The RA&HS is not a tax consultant and therefore assumes no liability for actions taken as a result of these guidelines. In any instances where an entrant or sponsor is uncertain of the tax implications of their involvement, they should consult their own accountant or tax advisor.

The Society makes every endeavor to ensure all prizes listed are accurate at the time of printing. Should a prize (cash, voucher, product, trophy) be withdrawn by a sponsor subsequent to printing, the Society will pay prize money as stated above. It is the responsibility of the prize winner to follow-up with the Society any sponsored prize (cash, voucher, product, trophy) they believe they are entitled to prior to 11 December in the year of the prize being awarded. The Society will not follow-up prize sponsors after this date or review any prizes that may have been incorrectly awarded.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show. A copy of the General Regulations can be obtained from the Society's website at www.theshow.com.au or from the Society's Administration Office. Exhibitors should note that the General Regulations contain a number of provisions relevant to competitions and this Schedule including but not limited to, offences, penalties, prohibited drugs. As those conditions apply in addition to the regulations contained within this schedule, Exhibitors should familiarise themselves with the General Regulations.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Special Regulations contained within this Schedule are merely supplementary to and subject to the General Regulations.

CAGES

The cages will be GCCFSA approved OWNER CAGES. Exhibitors are permitted to bring their own exhibition cages which meet the guidelines published by GCCFSA. Owner Cages are OC24 MAX 625mm x 455mm x 520mm (24.5" x 18" x 20.5") or OC30 MAX 765mm x 480mm x 535mm (30" x 19" x 21"). A limited number of hire cages are available for new or interstate exhibitors. PLEASE INDICATE THE CAGE SIZE FOR EVERY EXHIBIT WHEN ENTERING ONLINE OR ON ENTRY FORM. Double cages will not be available. Prior to judging, there shall be no interior or exterior distinguishing objects. Plain white or coloured curtains and blankets are permissible. Litter trays will be allowed in cages for kittens during judging. Trays must be unidentifiable.

EXHIBITS

No cat shall be removed between the hours of 7.15 am and 5.15 pm unless a veterinary certificate is produced stating that the cat is not fit to remain on the Showground. Removal of cats before the stipulated time of departure will render the owners and cats liable for disqualification. All exhibits must have all claws clipped. Domestic and Companion cats must be neutered by the age of six months. No cat or kitten shall be removed during the time it is on exhibition for any purpose whatsoever without the authority of the Convenor. The Society will under no circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of exhibits, or any injury thereto.

VETERINARY INSPECTION

All cats MUST arrive by 7.15 am every day for examination by the Society's veterinary surgeon. If approved, cats must be benched at once. No person, except the owner or his representatives, will be allowed in the pavilion until after the cats have been examined and benched. Any cat which shows symptoms of any disease, is lice infested and/or dirty, must be removed from the Showground immediately.

If any exhibit is rejected on the grounds of infectious or contagious disease, then no other exhibits from that cattery may be shown. The vet's decision is final.

UNATTENDED EXHIBITS

If an exhibit is to be left unattended whilst on show Stewards & Officials must be made aware. Stewards and Officials may tend to unattended exhibits as deemed necessary.

PRESENTATION OF EXHIBITION AREA

In an effort to improve the presentation and image of the Cat Section the Royal Adelaide Show, the RA&HS will provide chairs for exhibitors use when sitting with cats they have on exhibition. Exhibitors will not be permitted to supply their own chairs for use behind the barricades, as the chairs supplied by the RA&HS have been chosen to maximise the visibility for the public to view the cats on exhibition. Card tables and trolleys will not be permitted behind the barricades to showcase cats or catteries. Exhibitors should utilise the Exhibitor Area provided for this purpose.

AN EXHIBITOR AREA will be provided where exhibitors can spend time talking to the public, promote their cats, discuss individual arrangements for sales of kittens etc. Chairs and tables will be made available for the comfort of exhibitors and their guests. Exhibitors should be mindful that this is a shared area and discretion should be used when having lengthy conversations with members of the public or allowing crowds to pat cats. NO FOR SALE SIGNS PERMITTED.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

MONTH

Refers to a calendar month.

KITTEN

Entire or neutered exhibit over three months and under nine months on first day of The Royal Adelaide Show.

Entire and Neuter Kittens compete together.

CAT

Entire exhibit nine months and over on first day of The Royal Adelaide Show.

OPEN

All cats except Champions, Grand Champions and Double Grand Champions.

CHAMPION

A cat that has qualified for the title of Champion.

GRAND CHAMPION

A cat that has qualified for the title of Grand Champion.

DOUBLE GRAND CHAMPION

A cat that has qualified for the title of Double Grand Champion.

BRONZE DOUBLE GRAND CHAMPION

A cat that has qualified for the title of Bronze Double Grand Champion.

SILVER DOUBLE GRAND CHAMPION

A cat that has qualified for the title of Silver Double Grand Champion.

GOLD DOUBLE GRAND CHAMPION

A cat that has qualified for the title of Gold Double Grand Champion or above.

NEUTER

A cat that is not entire e.g. de-sexed.

OPEN NEUTER

All Neuters except Premier or Champions, Grand Premier or Grand Champions and Double Grand Premier or Double Grand Champions.

PREMIER NEUTER

A neuter that has qualified for the title of Premier Neuter or Champion Neuter.

GRAND PREMIER NEUTER

A neuter that has qualified for the title of Grand Premier Neuter or Grand Champion Neuter.

DOUBLE GRAND PREMIER NEUTER

A neuter that has qualified for the title of Double Grand Premier Neuter or above.

BRONZE DOUBLE GRAND PREMIER NEUTER

A neuter that has qualified for the title of Bronze Double Grand Premier Neuter.

SILVER DOUBLE GRAND PREMIER NEUTER

A neuter that has qualified for the title of Silver Double Grand Premier Neuter.

GOLD DOUBLE GRAND PREMIER NEUTER

A neuter that has qualified for the title of Gold Double Grand Premier Neuter or above.

JUNIOR
